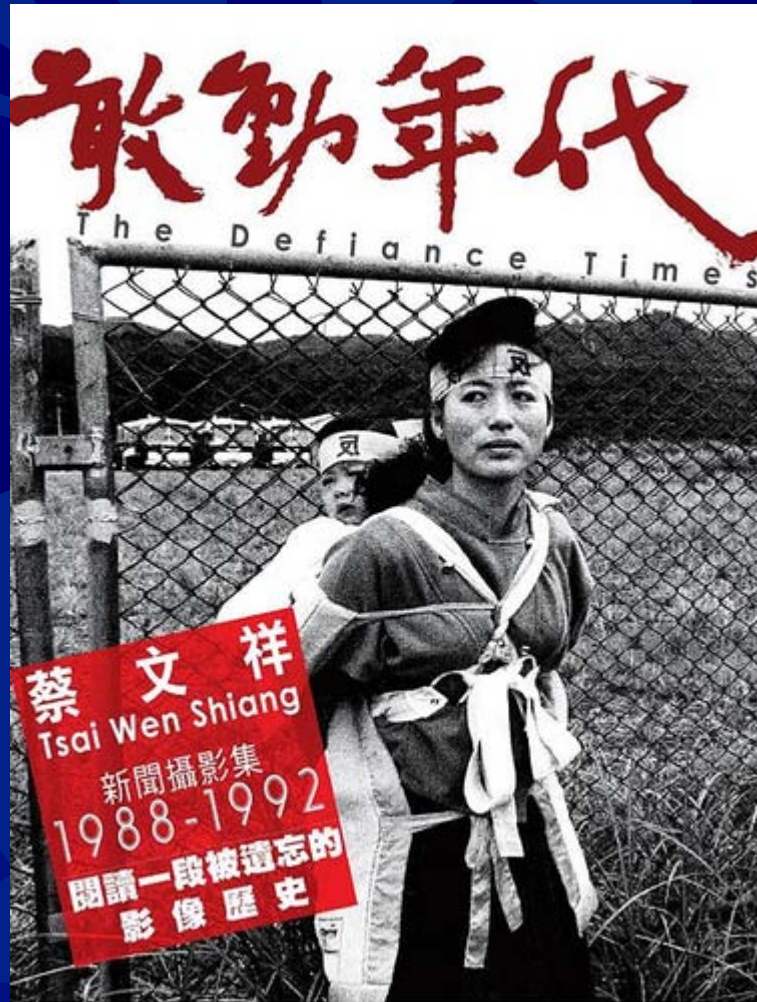


The Velvet Revolution (November 16 – December 29, 1989) was a non-violent revolution in Czechoslovakia that saw the overthrow of the Communist government.

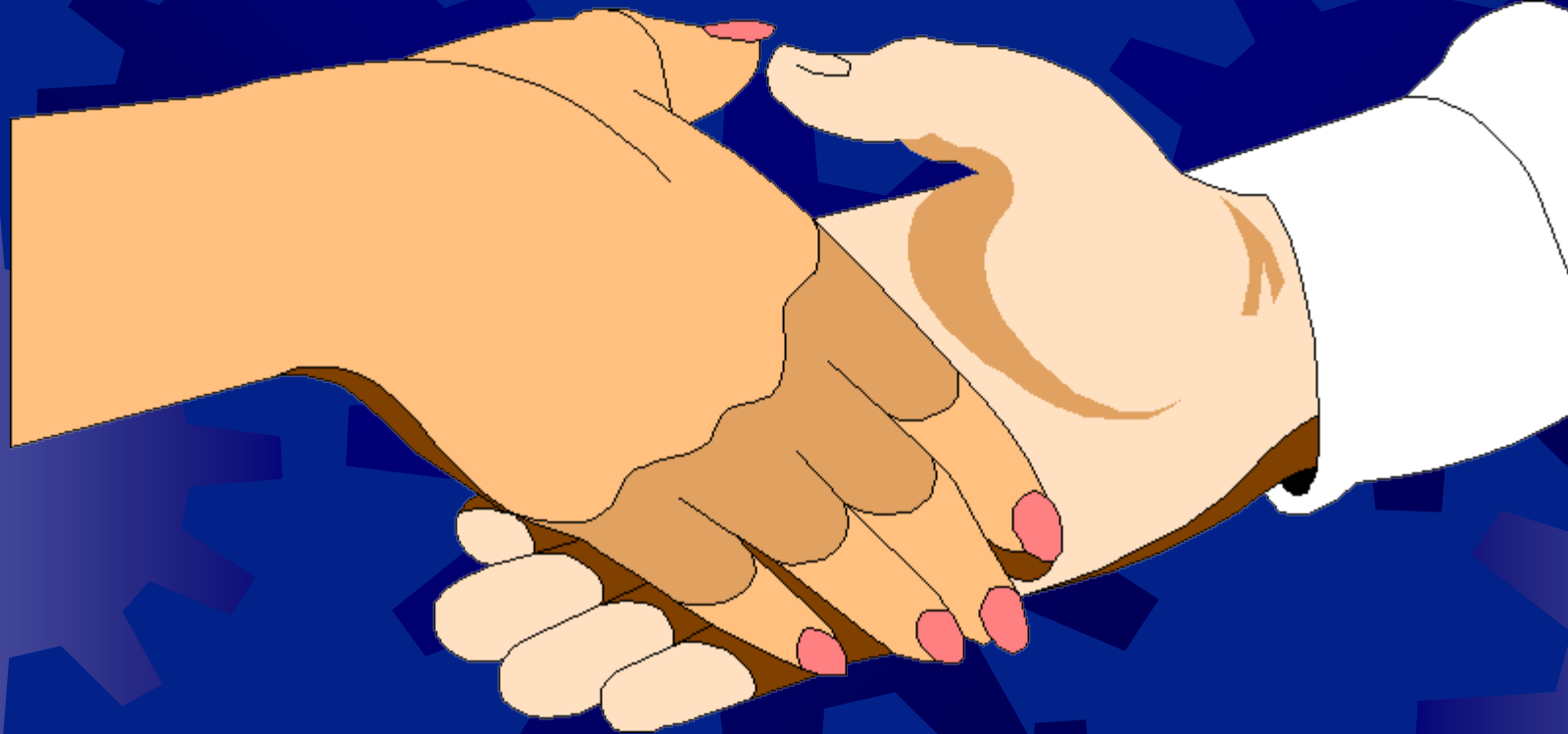


Memorial of the student manifestations of November 17th in Prague

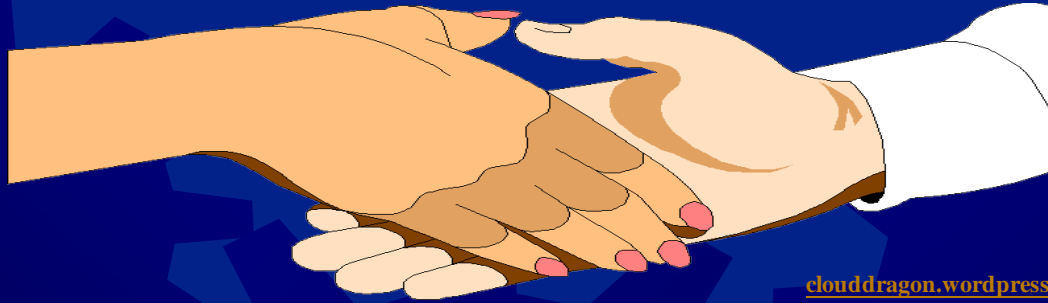

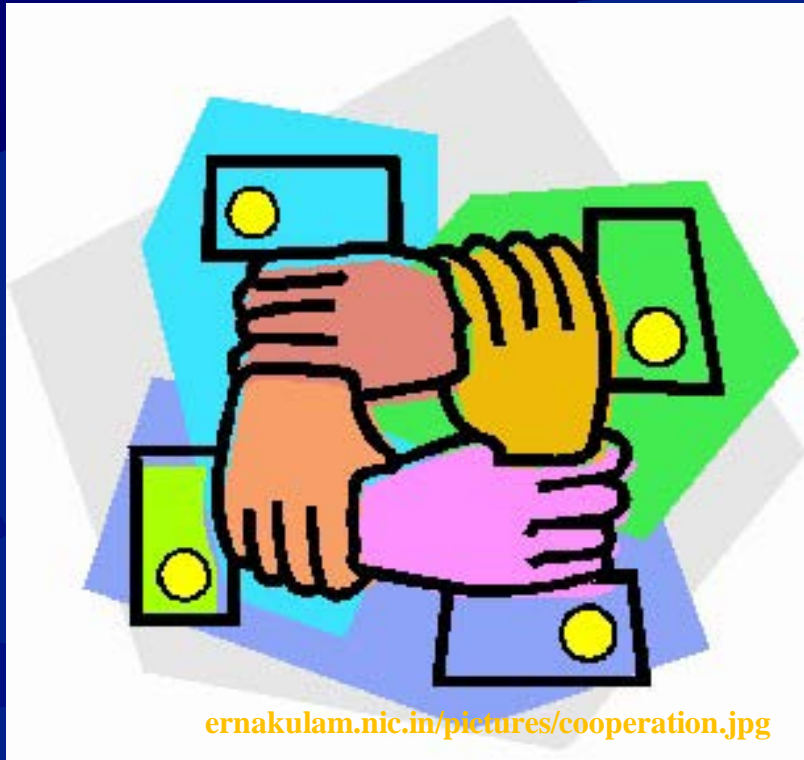

GENERAL AGREEMENT FOR
ACADEMIC COOPERATION AND EXCHANGE
BETWEEN
COLLEGE OF BIO-RESOURCES AND AGRICULTURE,
NATIONAL TAIWAN UNIVERSITY
AND
FACULTY OF SCIENCE,
UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH BOHEMIA IN CESKE BUDEJOVICE

College of Bio-Resources and Agriculture, National Taiwan University (Taiwan) and Faculty of Science, University of South Bohemia in Ceske Budejovice (Czech Republic) hereby enter into this General Agreement to foster international cooperation in education and research.

1. Both parties agree to encourage the following activities in particular to promote international academic cooperation:
 - a) Exchange of materials in education and research, publications and academic information;
 - b) Exchange of faculty members and research scholars in approved programs;
 - c) Exchange of students in comparable or similar degree programs;
 - d) Joint research activities and meetings for education and research which are agreeable to both parties following standard protocol.


Before these activities can be implemented, both parties shall discuss the issues involved to the satisfaction of each party and enter into specific Activity Agreements based on the forms of implementation mutually agreed upon.


2. This General Agreement shall be applicable to educational and research units attached to each party.
3. This General Agreement shall become effective as of the date of signature by the Deans of both parties. The amendment or termination of this General Agreement shall be effected upon mutual consent of the two parties.
4. Both parties agree that this General Agreement shall be reviewed approximately every five (5) years in order to evaluate progress and improve the quality of exchange.
5. Each party shall designate an office and the liaison professor for this General Agreement. For National Taiwan University, this office will be the Department of Entomology and the liaison professor will be Prof. How-Jing Lee. For the University of South Bohemia in Ceske Budejovice, it will be the faculty of Science and the liaison professor will be Prof. Libor Grubhoffer.

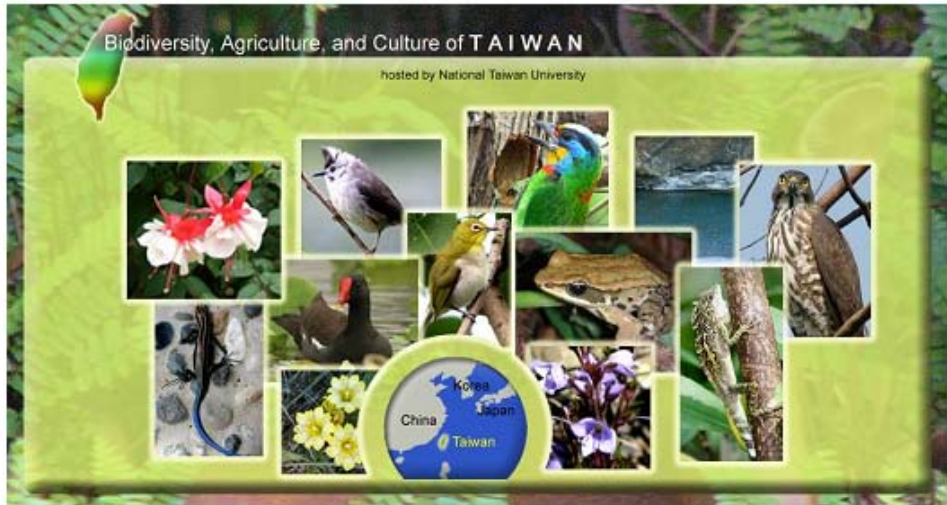
