History of science and theoretical research

A couple of claims to begin with:

- theoretical research in the humanities requires the free and therefore critical adoption of a paradigm, a tradition, its methods & goals;
- In Italian we say “la povertà aguzza l’ingegno”, i.e. to be a bit far away from the main traditions in linguistics can be a good opportunity to seek for a good one to work in

A more local premise

- A *fil rouge* through the history of philosophy and of linguistics: Anton Marty (1848-1914) and Vilém Mathesius (1882-1945):
 - one town = Prague
 - two Universities = the German and the Czech one
 - two disciplines = philosophy of language and general linguistics
 - one hidden continuity

Inferential competence vs referential

competence

- bookish learning vs learning by experience
- long-distance learning vs *in praesentia* learning
- remote events & contemporary witnesses
- knowledge by description and/or knowledge by acquaintance

Two books + the Velvet Revolution

- In 1982 I published *Anton Marty filosofo del linguaggio. Uno strutturalismo presaussuriano*, Roma
- In 1990 I published *Il Circolo Linguistico di Praga (1926-39) Radici storiche e apporti teorici*, Milano
- In 1989-90 it happened to me to feel astonished reading on the newspapers so often about Prague and the Velvet Revolution...I got the impression that what was on top of my mind was also on top of everybody's thoughts...
- What a nice opportunity to come to Prague in April 1990 to meet Josef Vachek, the last living witness of the golden age of the Prague Linguistic Circle and one of its most important mentors abroad!
